



# A QUANTITATIVE APPROACH ON LATIN OCCUPATIONAL EPIGRAPHY

**Abstract:** The current article is a catalogue-centered quantitative research concerning the occupational inscriptions of the Roman Latin West. The focus of the investigation were independent professionals – not linked directly to the state administration or the army – who have their profession explicitly recorded on a stone monument. The catalogue lists 691 individuals and links towards their detailed personal files; while exhaustiveness is a goal hard to achieve when covering a vast geographical area, we have tried to collect all attestations and are convinced we succeeded in rendering the huge majority of professionals epigraphically attested. The analysis is quantitative in nature and meant to contextualize the raw data of the catalogue.

**T**he current work presents some essential results of a long-term research on the occupational epigraphy of the Latin-language provinces of the Roman Principate. The focus on the Latin provinces is justified by the differences and even discrepancies existing between the epigraphic habits, as well as the ‘labour culture’ of the Greek and Latin parts of the Empire; nonetheless, Moesia Inferior, the utmost eastern province included in our research plan, serves as a case-study as well as a possible gateway to the future expansion of this scientific endeavour. Methodologically, we have worked exclusively on stone epigraphs and we did not include, out of obvious reasons of uniformity, state workers, imperial slaves and freedmen, as well as military personnel. Working only on the independent professionals offered a less biased view on the people who willingly found in profession an identity marker worth noting on a stone monument.

The study currently published is focused on the catalogue and the quantitative aspects revealed by the inscriptions. The main statistics undertaken on the raw information regard the nature of occupation, spacial distribution, the attested people and the monuments themselves. The article presents the information we extracted from occupational inscriptions in a systematic and quantitative manner. In order to make the results self-obvious, we decided to stick to the facts and the context they provide.

The catalogue, the core of our work, presents all people registered along their profession on stone monuments in the Western provinces of the Roman Empire; it does not comprise figurative representations, only the linguistic, explicit rendering of an occupational title was taken into consideration. Each person has a Romans1by1<sup>1</sup> ID and the corresponding link to the database; here, comprehensive data on the people and the monuments, as well as

other external links, are available. Besides the name and profession, one can find in the catalogue the province of provenience, dating and bibliographical reference. Regarding the bibliography, the purpose was not indicating all references, but the first or main (depending on the situation) sources where the inscriptions were published.

### ENCODING OF THE ATTESTED OCCUPATIONS

The first part of the full-scale quantitative analysis focused on the nature of registered professions. A specialized encoding and typology of these professions is presented below, but firstly, a couple of remarks are in order.

To encode the professional titles,<sup>2</sup> we used and adapted the *Historical International Standard Classification of Occupations* (HISCO).<sup>3</sup> These codes were later classified in HISCLASS,<sup>4</sup> HISCAM<sup>5</sup> and SOCPO<sup>6</sup> – systems that connect professions with social status. Although efficient for the periods they were intended for, they are completely inappropriate for the Roman era. For example, servile status is ignored, and the codes cannot be adjusted for the fact that high socio-economic classes are basically excluded from any professional/occupational category. We did not use any of them in the end.<sup>7</sup>

Online and in print,<sup>8</sup> the HISCO has been thoroughly documented, so there is no need to go into detail here. Basically, it offers a standard codification system for historical registered occupations (albeit only from Early Modernity to the present). The system is based on the HISCO tree, which contains nine major groups of professionals:

- 0/1** – Professional, technical and related workers;
- 2** – Administrative and managerial workers;
- 3** – Clerical and related workers;
- 4** – Sales workers;
- 5** – Service workers;
- 6** – Agricultural, animal husbandry and forestry workers, fishermen and hunters;
- 7-9** – Production and related workers, transport equipment operators and labourers.

Each major group contains minor groups, unit groups and micro groups as follows: minor groups: 01– physical scientists and related workers; 02 – architects, engineers and related workers; unit groups: 011 – chemists; 012 – physicists; micro groups: 01110 – chemist general; 01120 – organic chemist. Every occupational title in the unit group files is associated with a description and a link to equivalent occupational titles in various languages. Of course, these are modern languages, directing the search towards databases dealing with occupations and/or demographic databases for the eras indicated above.

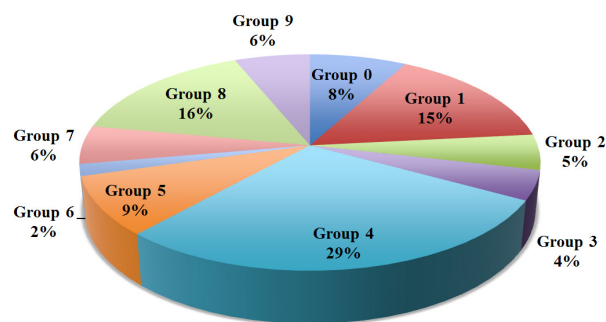

Adapting the system for occupational titles from the Roman era was rather painstaking as certain *mutatis mutandis* processes had to take place. We recorded 691 individuals associated with their profession. In terms of occupational titles, we identified 286 in the first raw phase (which more or less corresponds to the number extracted from pre- and early-industrial-era church registers, for an area more or less coinciding with a Roman province), and we were left with 225 after a minimum standardization. Why minimum? Because even with the risk of getting some technical glitches in the database and having to do part of the work manually, we preferred to stay true to the source and give more details of the occupation rather than opting for a general standard format. So, we have *negotiator artis alicariae*, *negotiator artis cervesariae*, *negotiator artis clostrariae*, *negotiator artis cretariae* and *negotiator artis cretariae et flaturariae* etc. We have opted to keep them as separate occupational titles in the database and unify them by an identical code.

In terms of occupational titles, the best represented major group is number 4 (sales workers). Besides the large variety of types of sellers attested, this group also raised a serious problem, and we were faced with the necessity of adapting the encoding system. In Latin (and the Roman world), it is often hard to make a clear-cut distinction (as the HISCO does) between a producer and a seller. Thus, for example, an *ampullarius* was highly likely to have not only produced flasks but also sold them, just as a *sagarus* would also (at least some of the time) produce the cloaks he sold and so on. These kinds of situations occur quite frequently, and a decision had to be made regarding the encoding as the HISCO does not have any codes for types of producer-sellers, let alone for all the multiple sub-specializations attested in inscriptions. The options were to adapt the codes and create new ones or assign general and/or two codes. We decided on the second solution as introducing new codes would make the system more opaque for other users. Two codes were, therefore, sometimes assigned: 4 3200 + 4 9090, the general codes for negotiator plus a specialized producer code. To use one of the above examples again, for *ampullarius*, we have code 8 9190 (other glass formers, cutters, grinders and finishers) + 4 9090 (other sales workers – as we do not know anything about his status as a seller). Into which category should we integrate such double-coded occupations for statistical purposes – both, none or according to historical realities? In some cases, the choice is immediately obvious, but in others, it is a matter of personal preference and methodological correctness (not historical content). Some

cases were clear, such as that of a *nauta negotiator*. Mariner and tradesman were assigned 9 8135 + 4 3200 codes, and occupational titles were introduced into Group 9 and Group 4, respectively; this was an easy example as we basically had two different titles pertaining to two groups, but functionally it illustrates the same situation as when two codes are allocated to a single title. In general, we included double-coded professions in both groups as this seemed to be the correct and by-the-book option when it comes to employing statistics. Another interesting case from our point

of view (and that of social history analyses) is *venaliciarius* (slave dealer) in Group 4. The HISCO does not provide anything remotely similar even though traders of slaves existed in the periods that the encoding system mainly deals with. It is hard to imagine that this line of business was a regular trade, but we had to assign it the general merchant code 4 3200.

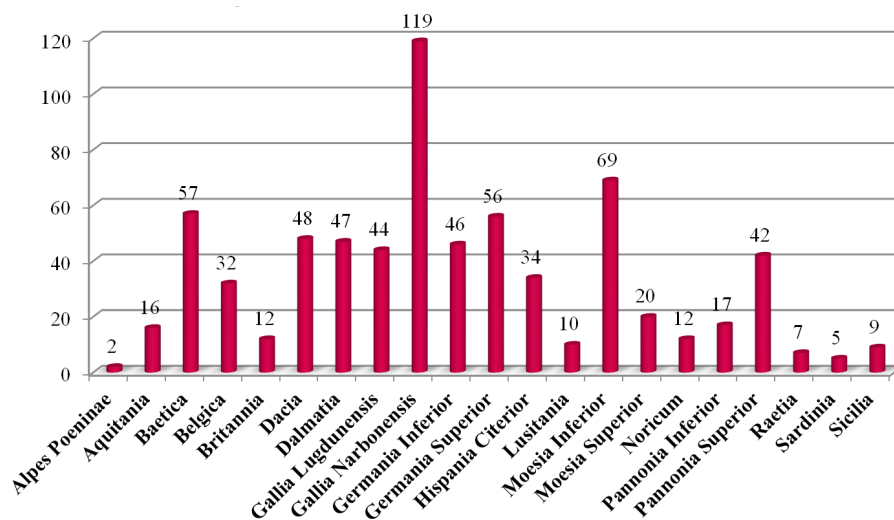
Other problems we faced when encoding in the HISCO were connected to the inner structure of the system itself. Thus, medical specializations did not have separate codes, which (in our opinion) would be very useful. For example, for *medicus ocularius*, one of the databases linked to the HISCO (*TRA preliminary version 1803–1970*)<sup>9</sup> encodes ophthalmologists with 0 7520,<sup>10</sup> but the description for this code is: *Optometrist – Examines eyes and prescribes spectacles or treatment not involving the use of medicines, surgery or drugs, to conserve or improve vision*. We did not opt for this and did not consider it appropriate as explicitly writing *medicus* on a monument implies pride in the medical training associated with this occupation and (in our opinion) excludes the auxiliary status. Equally, the system provides no separate codes for itinerant artists (*pictores peregrini* are attested). Journeymen have a code, but it is difficult to specifically track the profile of a professional artist. There are also no codes for amateur/private teachers,<sup>11</sup> as the encoding for teaching staff is completely dependent on the education level (primary, secondary, university, etc.). In all these cases, adjustments and integration into more general classes of codes were necessary.

In the general economy of research into occupational epigraphy, encoding is the first quasi-analytical step undertaken – right after the gathering and cataloguing of sources. With regard to social markers, it is clear that the most diverse and varied types of professionals took pride in their work status. Some had highly specialized occupations (*architectus*, *mentor*, *medicus*, etc.); others boasted ‘intellectual’ professions (*pedagogus*, *grammaticus*,

*adiutor tabularii*, etc.); and some definitely had a high economic status (*nauclerus*, *trierarchus*, etc.). These are the types of professions one would certainly expect to find on stone monuments. But we found a much larger variety of occupations, with the information sometimes coming from evidently poor monuments. The complexity and multitude of the occupational titles is hard proof of the fact that certain people identified with their profession regardless of what it was and that sometimes, even if modest, it became an important part of a person’s life and being.

## SPACE AND TIME

Besides the nature of the attested professions, the other two main coordinates are the spatial distribution of the monuments and their chronology.

As can be seen, the best represented provinces are the Gallic and Germanic ones. While Gallia Narbonensis is a province with general high epigraphic representativeness,<sup>12</sup> Germania Superior and Inferior both have a relatively modest epigraphy. Gallia Narbonensis is remarkable in terms of both quality and quantity, with almost all professions represented: merchants, medics, many and various types of craftsmen, private administrative personnel, architects and artists. On a smaller scale, the situation is replicated by Gallia Lugdunensis and Belgica. In the two Germanic provinces, the situation is a bit different. In Germania Inferior, 85% of the attested professionals were commercial workers, whereas Germania Superior is characterized by a slightly greater variety of occupations. One interesting feature of the latter is a relatively significant number of doctors and other medical workers, some – but not all – explicitly associated with the army. We must mention here that in our approach of the medical profession, we undertook a methodological liberty, namely to also consider the military doctors. This decision is motivated by the nature of the profession in itself, one can assume that at least certain doctors, attested in the areas of military camps (had) served the civilian environment as well.<sup>13</sup> Another province displaying a high degree of representativeness is Moesia Inferior, where we owe much to

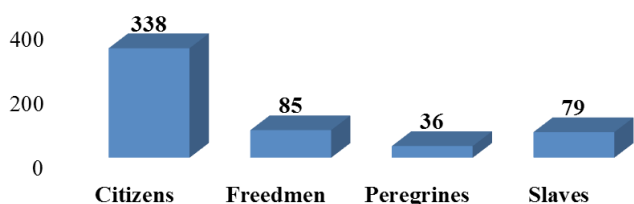
the province's Greek cultural background; inscriptions from the Greek world are often more descriptive, so mentioning one's profession appears as a more natural and neutral act than in the Latin speaking world.

The problem of chronology is more complicated and unfortunately does not render relevant results. The main difficulty associated with these monuments (private undertakings belonging to regular people rather than members of the elite, for whom real prosopographical reconstructions are often unattainable) is the impossibility of dating them with precision. Contextual data can sometimes help (archaeological context, connection with other inscriptions, onomastics, etc.), but the monuments in themselves provide little scope for exact chronology. Thus, only about 60 of the inscriptions (less than 10%) can be dated with relative accuracy, being placed within an interval of 50–80 years. Approximately 100 other inscriptions can be dated to within the span of a century; as for the rest, they can be dated to within a century and a half or even two hundred years.

**PEOPLE AND MONUMENTS**

The focus of this research, borne out by data in the Romans1by1 database, is the people; the professionals who chose to register their profession – or that of commemorated loved ones – on stone inscriptions.

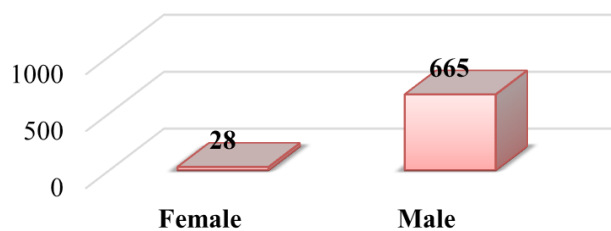
The first analysis focuses on juridical status, as we wanted to identify servile workers and establish whether there was a preponderant association with certain professions or areas of the Empire. Out of 691 persons registered, we could only determine the juridical standing of 538 with a reasonable degree of scientific certainty. Not surprisingly, citizens form the vast majority. In the case of freedmen, we cannot identify a pattern. For slaves, we noticed an important leverage held by administrative professions (*vilicus, actor, dispensator, etc.*). These data reinforce the higher status that household slaves generally held, being, even in relatively modest provincial milieus, part of the *familia*.



Graph 3. Juridical status

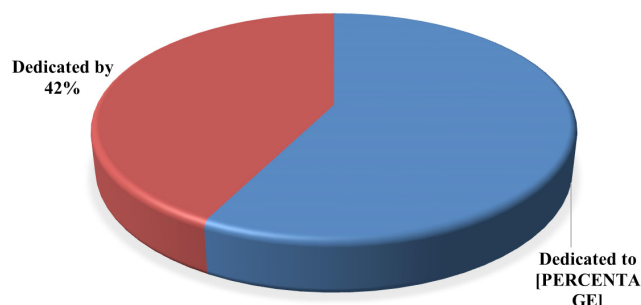
Another category we wanted to investigate was that of female professionals and we discovered a major underrepresentation of women. As can be seen on Graph 4, very few women recorded their professions on stone. Remarkably, 18 list medical professions (*medica, obstretix or nutrix*) and various other administrative functions. The province distribution is not relevant as the spread of the monuments is uniform, without zonal clusters. Although this might be surprising at first glance, it was normal to find many women in the medical field, and they were definitely more inclined to take pride in their profession than women

working in trade or crafts along with male family members. Equally, they had economic standing and a social position which justified immortalization of their profession on stone, as it probably was an important part of their public persona and private identity alike.



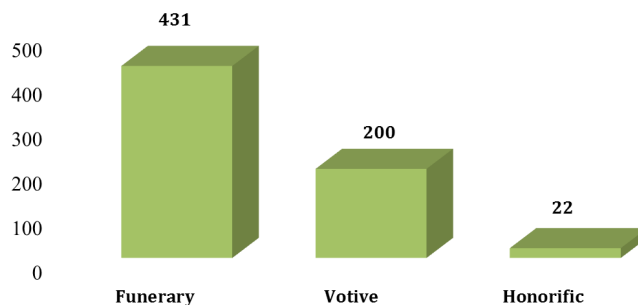
Graph 4. Gender distribution

The next analyses centred more on the monuments than their dedicators – although the epigraphs always offer information, albeit indirect, on the registered people too. One interesting feature was the object/subject of the dedications, and it seemed relevant to identify whether the professionals had listed their professions themselves or whether they were listed on monuments dedicated to them. This coordinate could not be determined for all inscriptions, but we finally identified 291 people as being dedicators and 394 as being persons to whom monuments were dedicated. This result came as something of a surprise as it seemed that in most cases the family and heirs were keen to stress on the profession of their loved ones. Of course, this probably also accorded with the wishes of the deceased.

In terms of dedications, we also had to investigate the type of monument. As can be seen below, the vast majority of monuments were funerary – to be expected given that

epitaphs tend to preponderantly provide biographical details about the deceased.

## CONCLUSIONS

This investigation was meant to be a systematization of the raw data presented by the catalogue. The main findings of these quantitative inquiries indicate that (from a geographical point of view) there was a stronger manifestation area in Gallic and German provinces and (from the occupation angle) a certain prevalence of traders. Besides the epigraphic representativeness and dimension of the sample, this is also an illustrator of epigraphic habits, especially in the German case. The predominance of funerary monuments was to be expected, and it correlates with the slightly higher quantity of inscriptions dedicated to professionals (as compared to the ones dedicated by themselves). Remarkable highlighted features are the extremely low number of women registered, their prevalent association with the medical profession, as well as the tie-up of the attested slaves with household administrative duties.

From this brief overview, one can clearly see that cataloguing all the attested occupational inscriptions opens new doors and can offer us an overview without which the role and place of work in Roman society will never be fully grasped. We hope that the here presented catalogue will be an useful tool for scholars and the quantitative analyses will serve for the contextualization of various aspects of Roman provincial social history.
